

Setup your Outlook 2002 Client

* Replace yourdomain.com with your actual domain name in all instructions below

1. Open Outlook 2002.
2. Click the **Tools** menu and select **Accounts...**
3. Click **Add** and then click **Mail...**
4. Enter your name in the **Display name:** field and click **Next**.
5. Enter your full Mail email address (username@yourdomain.com) in the **Email address:** field and click **Next**.
6. Enter 'mail.yourdomain.com' in the **Incoming mail (POP3, IMAP or HTTP) server:** field. Enter mail.yourdomain.com in the **Outgoing mail (SMTP) server:** field.
7. Click **Next**.
8. Enter your Mail username (including '@yourdomain.com') in the **Account name:** field. Enter your Mail password in the **Password:** field and click **Next**.
9. Click **Finish**.
10. Highlight mail.yourdomain.com under **Account** and click **Properties**.
11. Click the **Servers** tab and tick the box next to **My server requires authentication**.
12. Click **OK**.
13. Don't forget to click **Save Changes** when you've finished.
14. Download the latest updates for Outlook from Microsoft. This will help prevent the most common Outlook errors.
