

Setup your Outlook 2003 client

* Replace yourdomain.com with your actual domain name in all instructions below

1. Open Outlook 2003.
2. Click the **Tools** menu and select **Email Accounts...**
3. Click **Add a new email account** and click **Next**.
4. Choose **POP3** as your server type by clicking the radio button and click **Next**.
5. Fill in all necessary fields to include the following information:

User Information

Your Name: Enter your name as you would like it to appear in the From: field of outgoing messages.

Email Address: Enter your full Mail email address
(*username@yourdomain.com*)

Server Information

Incoming mail server (POP3): mail.yourdomain.com

Outgoing mail server (SMTP): mail.yourdomain.com

Login Information

Username: Enter your Mail username (including *@yourdomain.com*)

Password: Enter your Mail password

6. Click **More Settings...** and then click the **Outgoing Server** tab.
7. Click the **Servers** tab and tick the box next to **My server requires authentication**.
8. Click **OK**.
9. Click **Next** and then click **Finish**.
10. Don't forget to click **Save Changes** when you've finished.
11. Download the latest updates for Outlook from Microsoft. This will help prevent the most common Outlook errors.
